ORDINANCE #2003-03

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 4 OF
THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FAIRFIELD REGARDING
OMNIBUS LICENSES SECTION 4-1.1 FOR TENT SALES

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have determined that retail businesses in certain zones of the Township may derive benefit from the conduct of tent sales; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Mayor and Council to promote the vitality of business enterprises in the Township who keeping harmony with the interests of the residents of the Township; and

WHEREAS, concurrently with said goals the Mayor and Council recognize the need to regulate the conduct of said tent sales.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FAIRFIELD, COUNTY OF ESSEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:


1. Chapter IV of the Code of the Township of Fairfield is hereby amended and/or supplemented as follows:

4-1.1 Required Licenses. No person, persons, corporation or corporations, shall conduct a tent sale, swimming pool, restaurant, lunchroom, hotel, boardinghouse, lodging house, traveling or other show, circus, play, dance, exhibition, concert, theatrical performance, auction, fashion show, street parade, theater, show house, opera house, concert hall, dance hall, or billiard parlor, exhibition ground or other place of public amusement without having first obtained a license for that purpose from the Clerk of the Township of Fairfield in accordance with the provisions of this Chapter.

4-1.1a. Requirements for Tent Sales.


1. Tent Sales may only be conducted in the H-D, C-1 and C-2 zones.
2. A license to conduct a tent sale may only be issued to any applicant once each calendar year and may only be conducted for no more than four (4) days, consecutively.
3. Applicants must submit, with their application, a diagram of the premises where said tent sale is to be conducted, delineating areas for the conduct of business and parking, and the manner of ingress and egress for vehicular traffic.

4. Applications for tent sales must be submitted no less than 45 days prior to the date of the event in order to allow for Township review.
2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication in accordance with law.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER IV OF
THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FAIRFIELD
REGARDING OMNIBUS LICENSES

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have reviewed the provisions of the Omnibus Licensing Ordinance to determine its present applicability; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have determined that certain activities or establishments do not promote the health and safety of the citizens of the Township of Fairfield, to wit bathhouses, road houses or tent sales;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FAIRFIELD, COUNTY OF ESSEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

1. The following provision of Chapter IV of the Code of the Township of Fairfield shall be amended to read as follows:

4-1.1 Required Licenses.

No person, persons, corporation, corporations, shall conduct a swimming pool, restaurant, lunchroom, hotel, boardinghouse, lodging house, traveling or other show, circus, play, dance, exhibition, concert, theatrical performance, auction, fashion show, street, parade, theater, show house, opera house, concert hall, dance hall, or billiard parlor, exhibition ground or other place of public amusement without having first obtained a license for that purpose from the Clerk of the Township of Fairfield (1969 Code §39-1; Ord.#95-16 §1)

4-2.1 Required Licenses for Owners or Occupants.

No owner, occupant or other person or persons having possession or care of any house or other building or room or any lot of land or premises within the Township shall suffer or permit the operating or conducting of any, swimming pool, restaurant, lunchroom, hotel, boardinghouse, lodging house, traveling and other show, circus, play, dance, exhibition, concert, theatrical performance, street parade, theater, show house, opera house, concert hall, dance hall, pool and billiard parlor, exhibition ground, without having first obtained a license for that purpose. (1969 Code §39-3)

2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication in accordance with law.
