

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 7 TRAFFIC OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FAIRFIELD, COUNTY OF ESSEX RELATING TO STOPPING OR STANDING PROHIBITED DURING CERTAIN HOURS ON CERTAIN STREETS

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Mayor and Council of the Township of Fairfield that it is necessary to amend Chapter 7 Traffic, Stopping or Standing Prohibited During Certain Hours on Certain Streets.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Township of Fairfield, County of Essex, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The following shall be an amendment to the Municipal Code of the Township of Fairfield, relating to Traffic:

Chapter 7. Traffic

Section 7-10 Stopping or Standing Prohibited During Certain Hours on Certain Days.

No person shall stop or stand a vehicle between the hours specified on any day (except Sunday and public holidays) upon any of the street or parts of streets described, except where other parking regulations have been provided for. (1969 Code § 71-26.6; Ord. No. 737; Ord. No. 912)

<i>Name of Street</i>	<i>Sides</i>	<i>Hours</i>	<i>Location</i>
Fairfield Rd.	a. Both	6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. All	Entire length with the exception of b.

The rest of this section shall remain the same.

This Ordinance amendment shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication according to law.

2. All Ordinances of the Township of Fairfield which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.
4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage, approval and publication as required by law.
